- 🐾 Our intent is to floor all dog day & night care areas with rubber flooring intended for dogs. It will be warmer, more shock resistant, and easier to clean with the purchase of a special floor-cleaning machine.

### Short Term Fixes:

- Pee Pads to catch male marking in the Lounge.
- Patch areas to level concrete floors in Lounge and Winston rooms.
- Lay linoleum, tile, or other surface that is easier to clean and more comfortable for Lounge & Winston Rooms. These rooms are used for smaller dogs and overnight guests of all sizes.
- Create easy to clean, movable resting benches that will withstand lots of playful pups in the doghouse areas and offer pups more choices.
  - Large crate and dog house—bottom half only
  - Creative idea needed... heavy duty plastic or rubber coated metal, sturdy low shelf, table, or platform. Should be at least 3' x 3' and elevated 10" to 24" or light enough to move.

- ❃ Our intent is to redecorate the front entrance with landscaping, paint, fencing, and possibly a mural.
- ❃ Our intent is to improve the parking area to make it easier to enter/exit and less intrusive to dogs playing outside.
- ❃ Our intent is to install cameras and a system to monitor all dog areas from the office and enable you to see online what your pup is up to at Red Rover.
- ❃ Our intent is to construct 10 - small “rooms”, of concrete block or other suitable material, in Lounge and Winston Rooms for dogs to rest and/or eat alone during the day or night.
- ❃ Our intent is to purchase air filtration units to create healthier, better smelling air for all of us.
- ❃ Our intent is to construct or purchase and install better barriers to create pretty, easy to clean areas in the were-house while

maintaining the great character and space of the 1930's semi-circular, wood ceiling.

- ❃ Our intent is to install solar panels to reduce electric/gas consumption and to maintain a very comfortable temperature in the entire Red Rover building.

Short Term Fixes:

- Purchase and install a vent-free, propane fireplace in hallway to warm the front area more effectively.
- ❃ Our intent is to paint and resurface the floor in the entry for an easier to clean, prettier view of Red Rover from the front.
